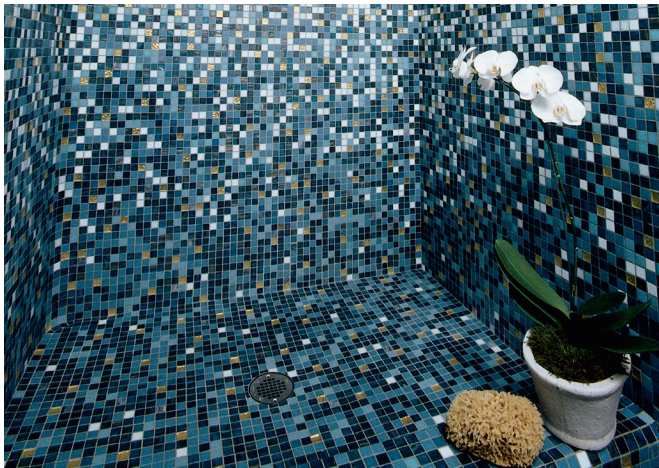

INSTALLATION

Surface Preparation
